Throughout her legal career, Marsha Levick has been an advocate for children's and women's rights and is a nationally recognized expert in juvenile law. Ms. Levick oversees Juvenile Law Center's litigation and appellate docket. She spearheaded Juvenile Law Center's exposure and subsequent litigation arising out of the Luzerne County, Pennsylvania juvenile court judges' corruption scandal, known as the "kids for cash" scandal, where Juvenile Law Center successfully sought the expungement and vacatur of thousands of juveniles' cases before the Pennsylvania Supreme Court, and is pursuing civil damages for the children and their families in a federal civil rights class action.
